A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY LEAGUE OF CITIES, INC. PROCLAIMING OCTOBER 22, 2013, "ETHICAL GOVERNANCE DAY 2013"
